

Outdoor Scavenger Hunt

Grab a tray or an egg carton and head outside - your front and back yard, your neighborhood, a nearby park or lake! You can use this worksheet over several days and trips outside. It does not have to be conquered all at once.

On this side of the sheet find 6 small items that represent each of the following opposites:

Light vs. Heavy

Round/Spherical vs. Flat

Fragrant vs. No smell

Alive vs. Dead

Smooth vs. Rough

Soft vs. Spiky

Skinny vs. Wide



OTHER IDEAS:

- Find 8 different leaves, arrange them from smallest to largest
- Find 9 of two different items each. Create a pattern that repeats three times.
 - Examples
 - Small, small, large / small, small, large / small, small, large
 - Green, red, green / green, red, green / green, red, green
- Find 6 things that make noise when you shake them
- Find a rainbow of colors
 - Red, orange, yellow, blue, green, and purple
- Find pairs of items that start with the same letter
 - Stick and stone
 - Petal and pine cone
 - Bark and berry
 - Weed and willow
 - And so many more!
- Find items shaped like animals - trees, rocks, wood chips, etc.
- Find twigs shaped like letters and spell your name - if you need to break them to make the letter, that's okay too!
