LOGISTICS & SCHEDULE

- Label your crockpot with team name and contact information
- We will provide table, chairs, and signage (including team name, chili name, and dietary considerations) and bowls, spoons, and napkins for guests
- You need to bring your own crockpot, serving utensils (ladle, spoon rest, small spoon for tasting cups), and dishes for any additional toppings
- This year you will each have your own table and we encourage table decorations!
- **1:30 p.m.** - Bring HOT chili to Delmar Gardens (1225 SW 2nd); set up space
- **2 p.m.** - Event starts
 - Community voting from 2-4:30 p.m. Each guest gets one free voting ticket, they can buy additional votes for \$1 each. Tell your friends to buy a ticket! 😊
- **3-3:30 p.m.** - Celebrity judging takes place.
- **4:30 p.m.** - Announcement of winners. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
- **5 p.m.** - Tear-down
